Hazardous Waste (Regulation of Exports and Imports) Act 1989

**BASEL EXPORT PERMIT
AUH0886831**

I, Barry Reville, Assistant Secretary, Environment Protection Branch, Department of the Environment, Water, Heritage and the Arts, by virtue of the powers delegated to me by the former Minister for the Environment and Heritage on 8 April 2004, having regard to the matters referred to in section 17 of the *Hazardous Waste (Regulation of Exports and Imports) Act 1989* and pursuant to my powers under that Act, grant a permit to TES-AMM (Australia) Pty Ltd, 26 Sleigh Place, Wetherill Park, New South Wales 2164 in Australia for the export of up to 1,440 tonnes of waste electrical and electronic scrap to TES-AMM (Singapore) Pte Ltd, 1 Joo Koon Way, Singapore 628942.

The waste must be packed into cardboard containers which must be waterproofed and secured by shrink-wrapping onto pallets. The waste must then be packed into shipping containers and transported by road, to be loaded onto ships at any of the Ports of Sydney, Melbourne, Adelaide, Perth or Brisbane, Australia, to be offloaded at the Port of Singapore. From there it must be transported by road to TES-AMM Singapore Pte Ltd, No. 1 Joo Koon Way, Singapore 628942 where it must be tested before being sent for repair, for reuse or recycling. Any waste that cannot be repaired must be disposed of by operation R4 'recycling/reclamation of metal compounds' as described in Annex IVB of the Basel Convention on the Transboundary Movements of Hazard Wastes and Their Disposal.

This permit includes and is subject to the conditions that are specified in the attached list, which forms part of the permit. No shipment is authorised under this permit before the 26 March 2009 or after 25 March 2010.
